With the opening of Africa University's satellite campus in Mozambique, students who cannot go to the Zimbabwe campus will have the opportunity to explore higher education. "For the first time we will have a physical presence in another country," notes Nodumo Dhlamini, a director at Africa University.

Bishop João Somane Machado of the Mozambique Area adds: Offering classes in Portuguese "will cut a year off the time our students must spend at Africa University because it takes them a year to learn English."

"I'm part of it," proudly states Tshishinen Mutebchingej, an Africa University theology student from the Democratic Republic of Congo.
