Isaiah 58:6-11

6Is not this the fast that I choose: 7to loose the bonds of injustice, 8to undo the thongs of the yoke,9to let the oppressed go free,10and to break every yoke? 11Is it not to share your bread with the hungry,12and bring the homeless poor into your house;13when you see the naked, to cover them,14and not to hide yourself from your own kin? 15Then your light shall break forth like the dawn,16and your healing shall spring up quickly; 17your vindicator* shall go before you,18the glory of the Lord shall be your rearguard. 19Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer;20you shall cry for help, and he will say, Here I am.

21If you remove the yoke from among you,22the pointing of the finger, the speaking of evil, 23if you offer your food to the hungry24and satisfy the needs of the afflicted,25then your light shall rise in the darkness26and your gloom be like the noonday. 27The Lord will guide you continually,28and satisfy your needs in parched places,29and make your bones strong;30and you shall be like a watered garden,31like a spring of water,32whose waters never fail.
