ROSEMOUNT UMC IS TAKING PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES against the spread of the swine flu by following the recommendations from the Governor's Council on Faith and Community Service. It is urging congregations to avoid use of communal cups, at least for the fall. It's even urging that hand contact be avoided for the time being. Also urged is the placement of hand sanitizers in pews or near entrances to church buildings.

Worshippers with a fever are being warned to avoid their places of worship, as they would any public place, for at least 24 hours after their fever has lifted. Churches are also warned to consider not holding potluck events during flu season.
